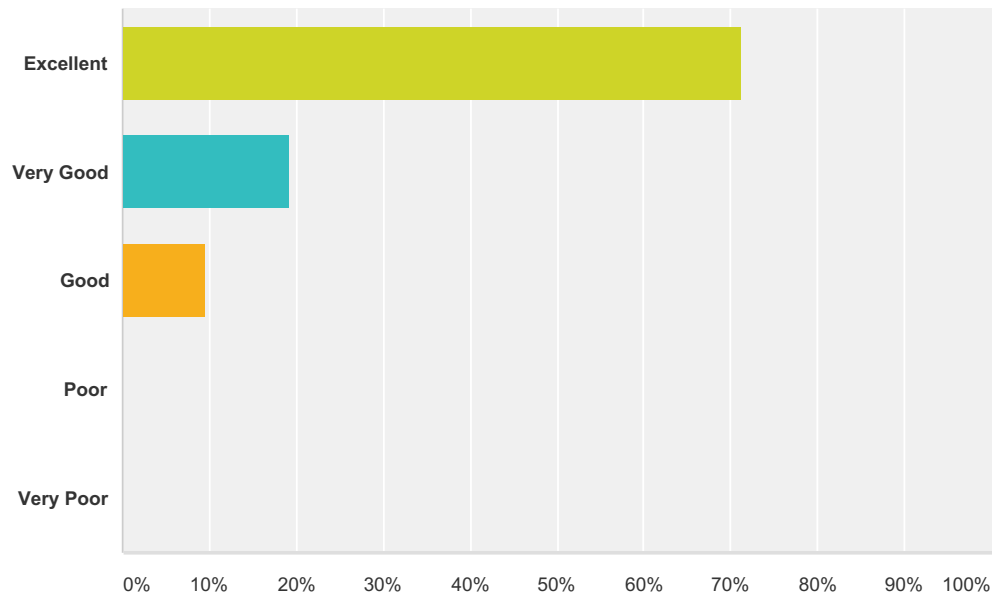


### Q1 Overall How would you rate the 2016 Course?

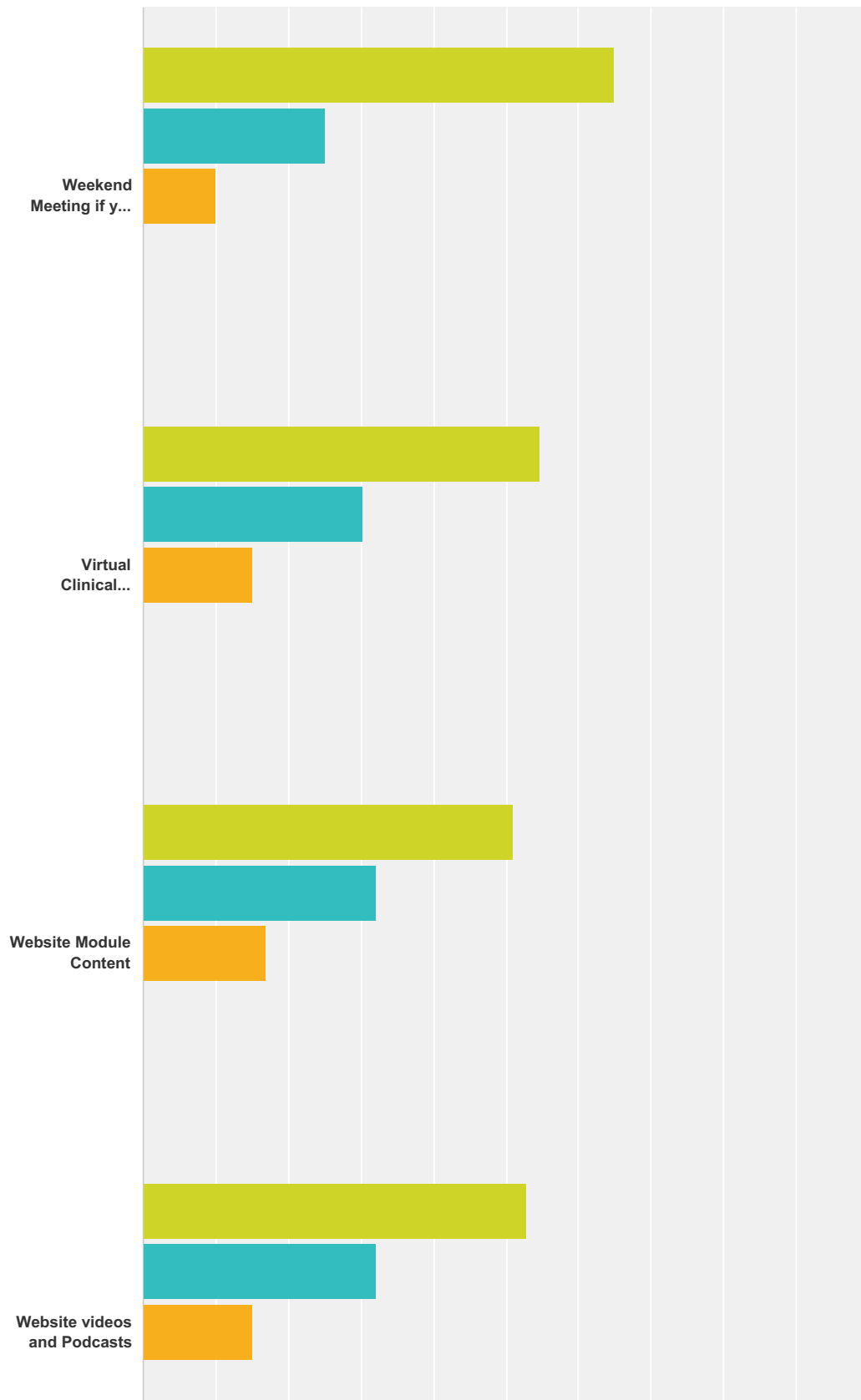

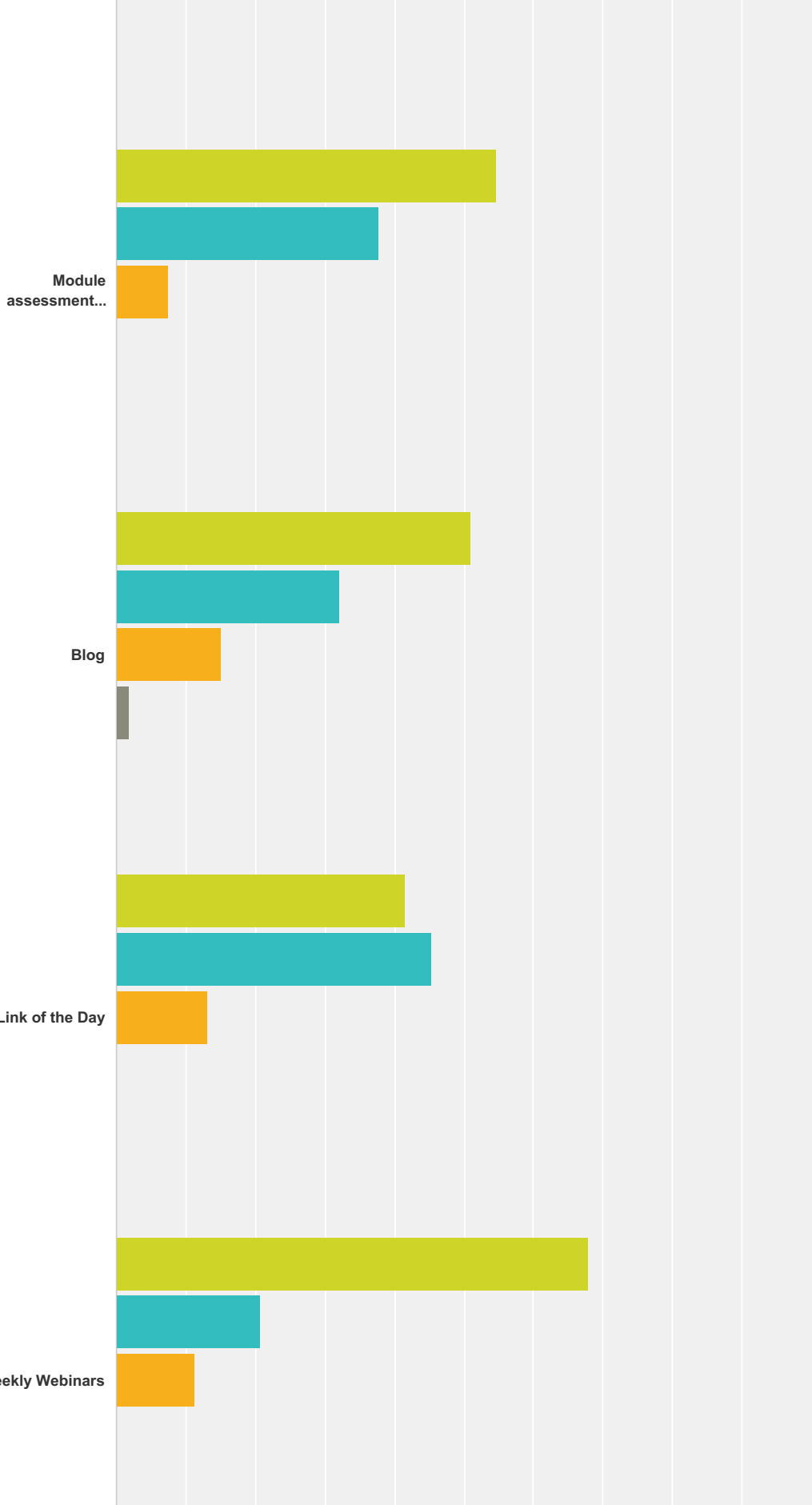

## Q2 How would you rate each part of the course?

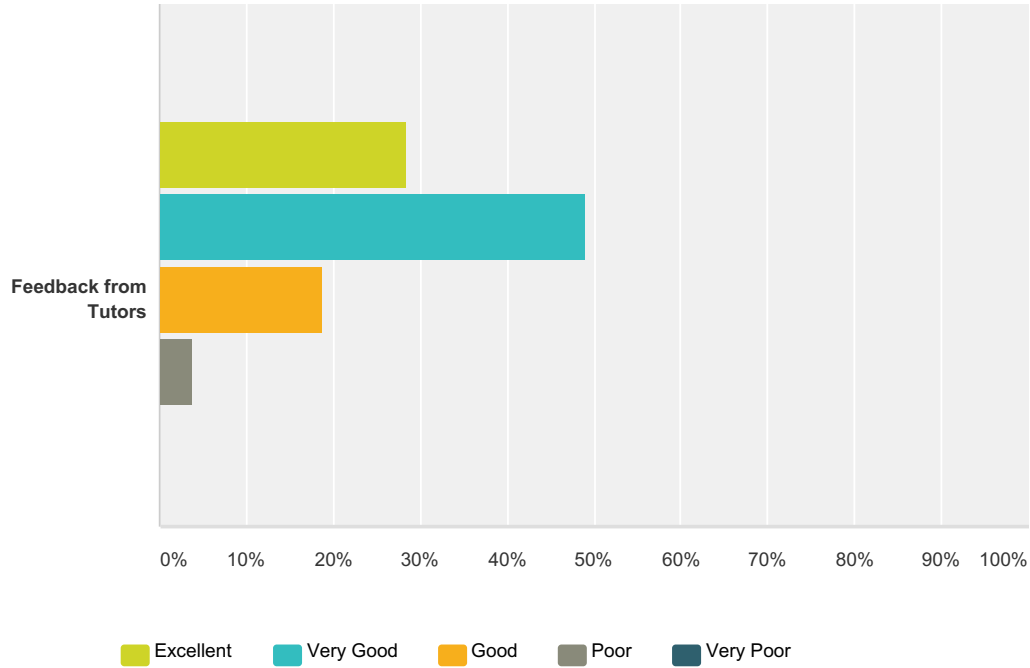

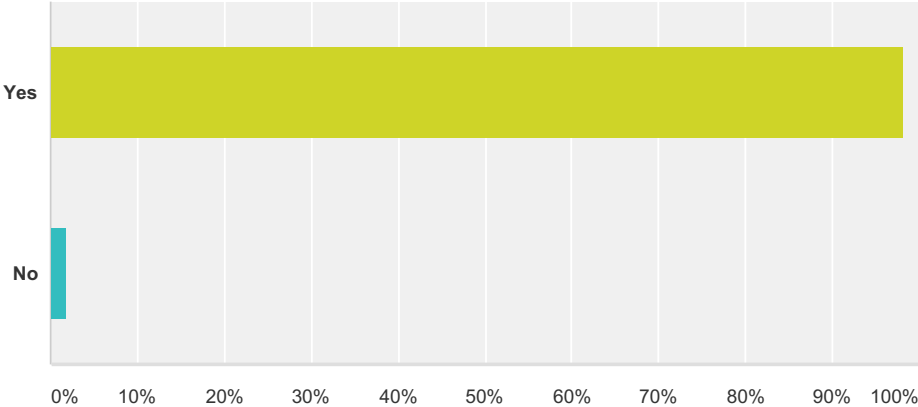

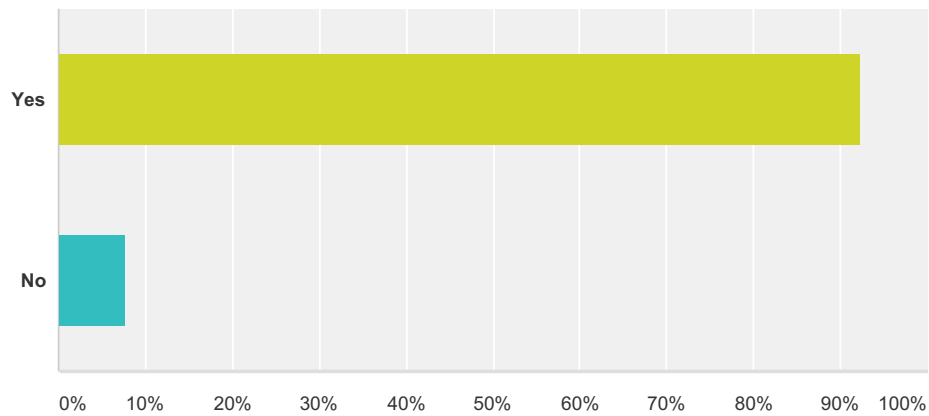
